

I can't get to God's <u>destination</u> if He's not <u>leading</u>.

14 For all who are led by the Spirit of God are children of God. Romans 8:14 (NLT)

What makes our experience great:

We're not in <u>charge</u>.

For our experience to be great:

We have to <u>relax</u> and let God <u>lead</u>.

25 Since we are living by the Spirit, let us follow the Spirit's leading in every part of our lives. Galatians 5:25 (NLT)

5 STOPS: That keep us from being led by the Spirit.

• I can't follow a culture that's not following God.

2 Do not copy the behavior or values of this world. Instead, let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think. Then you will know what God wants you to do, and you will know how good and pleasing and perfect his will really is! Romans 12:2 (NLT)

I can't follow <u>friends</u> who aren't <u>led</u> by God.

7 Do not let anyone lead you the wrong way! Christ is righteous, so to be like Christ, you must do what is right. And anyone who keeps on sinning is being led by the Devil." 1 John 3:7 (NCV)

I can't look to <u>other</u> <u>sources</u> besides God.

I can't be led by my <u>circumstances</u>.

Example from Paul: Acts 27:10,13-15

I can't be led by my <u>feelings</u>.

12 You may feel you're on the right road and still end up dead. Proverbs 14:12 (CEV)

20 Even if we feel guilty, God is greater than our feelings, and he knows everything. 1 John 3:20 (NLT)

5 Starts: To being led by the Spirit:

It starts with a <u>relationship</u> with <u>Jesus</u>.

16 The Spirit himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God... Romans 8:16 (ESV)

I have to want to be led.

16 So I say, let the Holy Spirit guide your lives. Then you won't be doing what your sinful nature craves. Galatians 5:16 (NLT)

Look to <u>God's Word</u>.

16 All Scripture is inspired by God... 2 Timothy 3:16 (NLT)

26 But when the Father sends the Advocate as my representative—that is, the Holy Spirit—he will teach you everything and will remind you of everything I have told you. John 14:26 (NLT)

I start <u>thinking</u> about things that <u>please</u> God.

5 Those who are dominated by the sinful nature think about sinful things, but those who are controlled by the Holy Spirit think about things that please the Spirit. Romans 8:5 (NLT)

• I start living to please the Spirit.

8 Those who live only to satisfy their own sinful nature will harvest decay and death from that sinful nature. But those who live to please the Spirit will harvest everlasting life from the Spirit. Galatians 6:8 (NLT)
