1 This letter is from Peter, an apostle of Jesus Christ. I am writing to God's chosen people who are <u>living as foreigners</u> in the provinces of Pontus, Galatia, Cappadocia, Asia, and Bithynia. 1 Peter 1:1 (NLT)

#### We need to understand:

This is not our <u>home</u>.

14 "You are the light of the world—like a city on a hilltop that cannot be hidden. Matthew 5:14 (NLT)

6 So be truly glad. There is wonderful joy ahead, even though you have to endure many trials for a little while.

7 These trials will show that your faith is genuine... 1 Peter 1:6-7 (NLT)

#### A necessary perspective:

- God may not make these temporary trials <u>go</u> <u>away</u>, but there is <u>joy</u> ahead.
- Our trials have a purpose.

#### False Faith:

- Inherited Faith.
- Shallow Faith.
- Conditional Faith.

## How God uses your trials:

## Trials <u>reveal</u> your <u>faith</u>.

7 These trials will show that your faith is genuine... 1 Peter 1:7 (NLT)

A faith that has been tested is

### a faith that can be trusted.

<sup>31</sup> "Simon, Simon, Satan has asked to sift all of you as wheat.
<sup>32</sup> But I have prayed for you, Simon, that your faith may not fail. And when you have turned back, strengthen your brothers." Luke 22:31-32 (NLT)

## Trials <u>develop</u> your <u>faith</u>.

2 Consider it a sheer gift, friends, when tests and challenges come at you from all sides.

3 You know that under pressure, your faith-life is forced into the open and shows its true colors.

4 So don't try to get out of anything prematurely. Let it do its work so you become mature and well-developed, not deficient in any way. James 1:2-4 (MSG)

## Trials draw you <u>closer</u> to <u>God</u>.

<sup>8</sup> You love (God) even though you have never seen him. Though you do not see him now, <u>you trust him</u>; and you rejoice with a <u>glorious</u>, <u>inexpressible joy</u>. <sup>9</sup> The reward for trusting him will be the <u>salvation of your souls</u>. 1 Peter 1:8-9 (NLT)

Our faith isn't based on what we see,

Our faith is based on who God is.
