

Do what is right and trust God with the results.

Here are some questions that can be used in Connection Groups: These questions also work well for your personal time with God.

- What spoke most to you from Sundays Talk? Explain.
- Has this series inspired you to be different? In what ways?
- When you read Jesus' words in John 15:18-20, how does that make you feel?
- Do you feel you receive any persecution for following Jesus? explain.
- Does it surprise you that many feel Christians are being persecuted more now than at any point in history?
- If you're not persecuted, it could be because you're to in the game. The enemy attacks those who are a threat to him. What makes us a threat to the enemy? Are you a threat to him?
- If we are really honest, which of the 2 cycles most reflects you? Explain.
- Read 1 Peter 4:12-13, when it says "be very glad—for these trials make you partners with Christ in his suffering.." Is that your perspective too? How it that different from the world?
- Do you find it difficult to "do what is right, and trust God with the results", even in trials?
- This might take some time. Read 1 Peter 4:13, 4:19, 5:5-7. and 5:10 what are the things Peter lists that give us strength during persecution?
- Sum up, in your own words, how God wants you personally to be different?
