The key:

- The key to unrestricted grace is <u>love</u>.
- 1 Let love be your greatest aim...1 Corinthians 14:1 (TLB)

We know we live in love:

- When"I don't have to", becomes "I want to".
- When "I want to" becomes "I get to".

10 Therefore, whenever we have the <u>opportunity</u>, we should do good to everyone—especially to those in the family of faith. Galatians 6:10 (NLT)

13 For you have been called to live in freedom, my brothers and sisters. But don't use your freedom to satisfy your sinful nature. Instead, use your freedom to serve one another in love.

Another definition of Grace:

Grace = Jesus.

Opportunities to love:

To the weak - <u>Restore</u> them <u>gently</u>.

 $1\,$ Brothers and sisters, if someone is caught in a sin, you who live by the Spirit should restore that person gently...Galatians 6:1 (NIV)

To the discouraged - <u>Carry</u> their <u>burdens</u>.

 $2\;$ Carry each other's burdens, and in this way you will fulfill the law of Christ. Galatians 6:2 (NIV)

12 "Do to others whatever you would like them to do to you. This is the essence of all that is taught in the law and the prophets. Matthew 7:12 (NLT)

12 Since God chose you to be the holy people he loves, you must clothe yourselves with tenderhearted mercy, kindness, humility, gentleness, and patience.
13 Make allowance for each other's faults, and forgive anyone who offends you. Remember, the Lord forgave you, so you must forgive others.
14 Above all, clothe yourselves with love, which binds us all together in perfect harmony. Colossians 3:12-14 (NLT)
