1 Oh, the joys of those who do not follow evil men's advice, who do not hang around with sinners, scoffing at the things of God.

2 But they delight in doing everything God wants them to, and day and night are always meditating on his laws and thinking about ways to follow him more closely. Psalm 1:1-2 (TLB)

■ Support to live with.

■ Examples to live out.

Don't befriend angry people or associate with hot-tempered people, or you will learn to be like them and endanger your soul. Proverbs 22:24-25 (NLT)

17 A friend loves at all times, and a brother is born for adversity. Proverbs 17:17 (ESV)

■ The wrong friends can't lead me where God is taking me.

Who is it that God wants us to be?

- Fully Committed to Him.

May the God of peace himself make you entirely pure and devoted to God; and may your spirit and soul and body be kept strong and blameless until that day when our Lord Jesus Christ comes back again. 1 Thessalonians 5:23 (TLB)

1 ...I encourage you to offer your bodies as living sacrifices, dedicated to God and pleasing to him. This kind of worship is appropriate for you. Romans 12:1 (GW)
