Luke 14:21-23 (NIV)
- Every Christ follower is defined by who we "Know" and how we "Go".

A culture of invitation:

- It's a culture that inspires others.
- $28 \dots$ Back in the village she told the people, 29 "Come see a man who knew all about the things I did, who knows me inside and out. Do you think this could be the Messiah?"
- 30 And they went out to see for themselves. John 4:28-30 (MSG)
- 39 Many Samaritans from the village believed in Jesus because the woman had said, "He told me everything I ever did!" John 4:39 (NLT)
- It's a culture that shares with others.
- 44 And all the believers met together in one place and shared everything they had. 45 They sold their property and possessions and shared the money with those in need.
- 46 They worshiped together at the Temple each day, met in homes for the Lord's Supper, and shared their meals with great joy and generosity— Acts 2:44-46 (NLT)
- $47\,$...And each day the Lord added to their fellowship those who were being saved. Acts 2:47 (NLT)
- It's a culture of <u>Faith</u> that <u>brings</u> others along.
- 18 Some men came carrying a paralyzed man on a sleeping mat. They tried to take him inside to Jesus, 19 but they couldn't reach him because of the crowd. So they went up to the roof and took off some tiles. Then they lowered the sick man on his mat down into the crowd, right in front of Jesus.
- 20 Seeing their faith, Jesus said to the man, "Young man, your sins are forgiven." Luke 5:18-20 (NLT)

- 24 ..Then, turning to the paralyzed man, he commanded, "Pick up your stretcher and go on home, for you are healed!" Luke 5:24 (TLB)
- Few friends are true friends.

5 And now, through Christ, all the kindness of God has been poured out upon us undeserving sinners; and now he is sending us out around the world to tell all people everywhere the great things God has done for them, so that they, too, will believe and obey him. Romans 1:5 (TLB)

Friendship Evangelism is a culture:

- Willing to care.
- Willing to sacrifice for others.
- Have <u>faith</u> for their spiritual needs.
 Seeing their faith, Jesus said to the man, "Young man, your sins are forgiven." Luke 5:20 (NLT)
- Courage to <u>bring</u> others with you.

Application:

- Because I'm a friend I will invite others.
- Because I love them I will start the conversation.
- I will allow them to see Jesus in me.
- 7 So we have been greatly encouraged in the midst of our troubles and suffering, dear brothers and sisters, because you have remained strong in your faith.
- 8 It gives us new life to know that you are standing firm in the Lord.
- 9 How we thank God for you! <u>Because of you</u> we have great joy as we enter God's presence. 1 Thessalonians 3:7-9 (NLT)
