

27 "Woe to you, teachers of the law and Pharisees, you hypocrites! You are like whitewashed tombs, which look beautiful on the outside but on the inside are full of the bones of the dead and everything unclean. 28 In the same way, on the outside you appear to people as righteous but on the inside you are full of hypocrisy and wickedness... 33 "You snakes! You brood of vipers! How will you escape being condemned to hell? Matthew 23:27-28;33 (NIV)

1 ... "Beware of the yeast of the Pharisees—their hypocrisy. Luke 12:1 (NLT)

## The warning reminds us:

- What starts out good can go bad.
- What starts out <u>small</u> can become <u>big</u>.

## What Hypocrisy is not:

Hypocrisy is not the difference between what we <u>do</u> and what we <u>wish</u> we did.

15 What I don't understand about myself is that I decide one way, but then I act another, doing things I absolutely despise. Romans 7:15 (MSG)

- Hypocrisy is the difference between who I <u>claim</u> to be <u>publicly</u> and how I <u>live privately</u>.
- Hypocrisy is a <u>heart</u> issue; it's okay to mislead others when it <u>benefits</u> us personally.

**Hypocrisy:** the practice of claiming to have moral standards or beliefs to which our behavior does not conform.

16 Such people claim they know God, but they deny him by the way they live.... Titus 1:16 (NLT)

7 You hypocrites! Isaiah was right when he prophesied about you: 8 " 'These people honor me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me. Matthew 15:7-8 (NIV)

18 In the morning, as Jesus was returning to Jerusalem, he was hungry, 19 and he noticed a fig tree beside the road. He went over to see if there were any figs, but there were only leaves. Then he said to it, "May you never bear fruit again!" And immediately the fig tree withered up. Matthew 21:18-19 (NLT)

## Why hypocrisy is bad:

It makes us prideful.

## It allows us to live a lie.

2 We refuse to wear masks and play games. We don't maneuver and manipulate behind the scenes... Rather, we keep everything we do and say out in the open... 2 Corinthians 4:2 (MSG)

## It prevents us from experiencing <u>God</u>.

21 But whoever lives by the truth comes into the light, so that it may be seen plainly that what they have done has been done in the sight of God. John 3:21 (NIV)

### It looks nothing like <u>Jesus</u>.

20 So we are Christ's ambassadors; God is making his appeal through us. We speak for Christ when we plead, "Come back to God!" 2 Corinthians 5:20 (NLT)

#### Hope for the Hypocrite:

25 "Woe to you, Pharisees, and you religious leaders—hypocrites! You are so careful to polish the outside of the cup, but the inside is foul with extortion and greed. 26 Blind Pharisees! <u>First cleanse the inside of the cup, and then the whole cup will be clean</u>. Matthew 23:25-26 (TLB)

I'd rather be an honest sinner than a lying hypocrite.

13 People who conceal their sins will not prosper, but if they confess and turn from them, they will receive mercy. Proverbs 28:13 (NLT)

We have nothing to fear when we have nothing to hide.

23 Search me, O God, and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts. 24 Point out anything in me that offends you, and lead me along the path of everlasting life. Psalm 139:23-24 (NLT)

- We don't close the gaps with <u>perfection</u>.
- We close the gaps with <u>Christ</u>.

Questions that can be used in Connection Groups: These questions also work well for personal time with God.

- · What spoke most to you from the talk on Sunday?
- · Describe how you feel or what you think about when you hear the word "hypocrisy."
