## Why people don't tithe:

I give my <u>time</u> instead.

I give to those in <u>need</u>.

## I'm in <u>debt</u>.

## I don't trust the church.

Honor the Lord with your wealth and with the best part of everything you produce. Then he will fill your barns with grain, and your vats will overflow with good wine. Proverbs 3:9-10 NLT

## How your church wins when you tithe:

We **reach** people for Christ.

Go to the people of all nations and make them my disciples. Baptize them in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, and teach them to do everything I have told you. I will be with you always, even until the end of the world. Matthew 28:19-20 CEV
