

- The strength of your marriage isn't measured by your <u>feelings</u>, but rather your <u>commitment</u>.
- When it comes to your marriage, God is more concerned with your <u>direction</u> than <u>perfection</u>.

The big principle:

By nature, we <u>pursue</u> what we <u>don't</u> have.

We tighten the knot when:

- We need to have shared <u>pursuits</u>.
- 10 For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost." Luke 19:10 (NIV)
- 16 For God loved the world so much that he gave his only Son so that anyone who believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life. John 3:16 (TLB)

• We pursue God together.

37 Jesus replied: "'Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' 38 This is the first and greatest commandment. Matthew 22:37-38 (NIV)

33 But seek <u>first</u> <u>his kingdom</u> and <u>his righteousness</u>, and all these things will be given to you as well. Matthew 6:33 (NIV)

4 In his pride the wicked does not <u>seek (God)</u>; in all his thoughts there is no room for God...6 He says to himself, "Nothing will shake me; I'll always be happy and never have trouble." Psalm 10:4,6 (NIV)

Worship and serve him with your whole heart and a willing mind. For the Lord sees every heart and knows every plan and thought. If you seek him, you will find him. 1 Chronicles 28:9 (NLT)

We pursue God when we:

Pray together.

14 If my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then will I hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and will heal their land. 2 Chronicles 7:14 (NIV)

- Present the Bible together.
- Talk about what God is doing in your life.

We tighten the knot when:

• We continue to **pursue** each other.

Genesis 29

We pursue each other:

- When you think something good, say it.
- ²¹ The tongue has the power of life and death... Proverbs 18:21 (NIV)
- 1 How beautiful your sandaled feet, O prince's daughter! Your graceful legs are like jewels, the work of an artist's hands. ² Your navel is a rounded goblet that never lacks blended wine. Your waist is a mound of wheat encircled by lilies. ³ Your breasts are like two fawns, like twin fawns of a gazelle. Songs 7:1-3 (NIV)
- Pursue them with words of <u>affirmation</u>.
- Pursue them with words of <u>affection</u>.
- 3 What matters is not your outer appearance—the styling of your hair, the jewelry you wear, the cut of your clothes— 4 but your inner disposition. Cultivate inner beauty, the gentle, gracious kind that God delights in. 1 Peter 3:3-4 (MSG)
- •When you think something **special**, **do** it.
- 31 "Here is a simple rule of thumb for behavior: Ask yourself what you want people to do for you; then grab the initiative and do it for them! Luke 6:31 (MSG)

4...The love you had at first is gone. 5 Remember how far you have fallen. Return to me and change the way you think and act, and do what you did at first. Revelation 2:4-5 (GWT)
