Why we need to hear God:

- It quiets our <u>fears</u>.
- It protects us from making <u>mistakes</u>. Job 33:16-17 (MSG)
- It brings <u>guidance</u> to our lives. Isaiah 30:21 (NIV)
- It teaches us to <u>listen</u>. Jeremiah 7:23-24 (ESV)
- It identifies us as belonging to God.

John 10:27 (MSG)

John 8:47 (GWT)

14 For those who are led by the Spirit of God are the children of God. Romans 8:14 (NIV)

We need to understand:

- God wants to speak to us.
- God cares about the details of our lives.
- 18 When people do not accept divine guidance, they run wild. But whoever obeys the law is joyful. Proverbs 29:18 (NLT)

We might not be hearing God because:

- We don't believe that God wants to speak to us.
- We're too busy.
- We're listening for what we want to hear.
- God wants a conversation, we want answers.

How to tune in to God's voice:

If we don't follow through with the <u>little</u> things, we won't be dialed in for the big things.

- When we ignore God, we train our heart to tune God out rather than tune in.
- If we are not <u>open</u> to God's <u>purpose</u> for our life, we are only looking for answers to a self directed life.
- God speaks when we're surrendered to Him.

How God speaks:

Through His Spirit.

26 The Holy Spirit...he will teach you everything and will remind you of everything I have told you. John 14:26 (NLT)

- Through the scriptures.
- 2 Timothy 3:16-17 (TLB)
- Through other <u>believers</u>. Ephesians 3:10 (NIV)
- Through <u>Impressions</u>. Job 33:14-15 (NLT)

A few tests that are important:

- O Is it consistent with the <u>scriptures</u>?
- Does my <u>church family</u> confirm it?
- O Does it lead me to trust God more?

What do I need to do to hear God:

- I need to develop an open Heart.
- I need to make time to listen.
