

- 7 For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind. 2 Timothy 1:7 (NKJV)
- We can't actually be <u>fearless</u>, but we can <u>fear less</u>.
- Courage and faith are not responses in the <u>absence</u> of <u>fear</u>, but how we respond <u>in fear</u>.

In the Bible:

"Do not be afraid" is mentioned: 120 times!

"Do not fear" is mentioned: 131 times!

• Fear can **limit** or **leverage** you.

Fear can be a great benchmark:

- Fear reveals what we value most.
- Fear reveals where we <u>trust</u> <u>God</u> <u>least</u>.

Lessons from David with fear:

- Facing your fears with God increases your confidence in God.
- 1 The LORD is my light and my salvation— so why should I be afraid? The LORD is my fortress, protecting me from danger, so why should I tremble? Psalm 27:1 (NLT) 4 I prayed to the LORD, and he answered me. He freed me from all my fears. Psalm 34:4 (NLT)
- David didn't believe that the <u>strongest man</u> would win the fight; He believed <u>God</u> would <u>win</u> the fight.
- 37 <u>The LORD who rescued me</u> from the claws of the lion and the bear <u>will rescue me</u> from this Philistine!"... 1 Samuel 17:37 (NLT)
- David didn't see **himself** as the **answer** to the challenge.
- We face our fears through the lens of what we <u>stand</u> to <u>lose</u>, rather than what God <u>stands</u> to <u>gain</u>.
- 46 Today the LORD will conquer you, and I will kill you and cut off your head. And then I will give the dead bodies of your men to the birds and wild animals, and the whole world will know that there is a God in Israel! 47 And everyone assembled here will know that the LORD rescues his people,... 1 Samuel 17:46-47 (NLT)

How we build confidence in God:

We <u>believe</u> that God <u>rescues</u> His people.

• We **belong** to His **family**.

We're convinced that God is present.

10 Don't be afraid, for \underline{I} am with you. Don't be discouraged, for \underline{I} am your God. \underline{I} will strengthen you and help you. \underline{I} will hold you up with my victorious right hand. Isaiah 41:10 (NLT)

5 ...Since God assured us, "I'll never let you down, never walk off and leave you," 6 we can boldly quote, God is there, ready to help; I'm fearless no matter what. Who or what can get to me? Hebrews 13:5-6 (MSG)

We become convinced that God is present when we **focus** on Him rather than our **fears**.

- 3 You will keep in perfect peace all who trust in you, all whose thoughts are fixed on you! Isaiah 26:3 (NLT)
- 17 How precious are your thoughts about me, O God. They cannot be numbered!
- 18 I can't even count them; they outnumber the grains of sand! And when I wake up, you are still with me! Psalm 139:17-18 (NLT)

• We have **experience** with God's **abilities**.

37 <u>The LORD who rescued me</u> from the claws of the lion and the bear <u>will rescue me</u> from this Philistine!"... 1 Samuel 17:37 (NLT)

9 If you make the LORD your refuge, if you make the Most High your shelter, 10 no evil will conquer you; no plague will come near your home. 11 For he will order his angels to protect you wherever you go. Psalm 91:9-11 (NLT)
