

- 2 So here I am in the place of worship, eyes open, drinking in your strength and glory. Psalm 63:2 (MSG)
- 2 ...sing yourselves into his presence. Psalm 100:2 (MSG)
- Worship allows us to be present in His presence.
- An encounter with God changes everything.
- 1 ...Do not be afraid, for I have ransomed you. I have called you by name; you are mine. 2 When you go through deep waters, I will be with you. When you go through rivers of difficulty, you will not drown. When you walk through the fire of oppression, you will not be burned up; the flames will not consume you. 3 For I am the LORD, your God, ... your Savior. Isaiah 43:1-3 (NLT)

# Why we don't have to be afraid:

- God paid for your freedom from darkness.
- You matter to God.
- God knows you by name.
- Belonging to God comes with His <u>protection</u>.

# **Confidence in God:**

- ...begins with surrendering our lives to God.
- ...grows with experience.

10 Those who know you, LORD, will trust you; you do not abandon anyone who comes to you. Psalm 9:10 (TEV)

**yada:** the process of intimately <u>knowing</u> and <u>submitting</u> to someone by observing and experiencing.

We want God to prove Himself so we can trust Him.

### What we need to know about fear:

- Fear does not come from God.
- 7 For God did not give us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of self-control. 2 Timothy 1:7 (BBE)
- Fear is faith in our doubts.
- Fear causes us to question God's character.
- Fear imagines a life without God's presence.

8 Do not be afraid or discouraged, for the LORD will personally go ahead of you. He will be with you; he will neither fail you nor abandon you." Deuteronomy 31:8 (NLT)

We become fearful when what we stand to <u>lose</u> is greater than what we stand to <u>gain</u>.

# **Nurturing Trust in God:**

- Grow in your relationship with God.
- 33 Seek the Kingdom of God above all else, and live righteously, and he will give you everything you need. Matthew 6:33 (NLT)
- Take a step of faith.

8 Come close to God, and God will come close to you. James 4:8 (NLT)

- Get to know the **goodness** of God.
- Get to know the love of God.
- Get to know the faithfulness of God.

Know that the Lord is God. It is He who made us, and we are His; we are His people, the sheep of His pasture. Enter His gates with thanksgiving and His courts with praise; give thanks to Him and praise His name. For the Lord is good and His love endures forever; His faithfulness continues through all generations. Psalm 100:3-5 (NIV)

These questions also work well for personal time with God.
