TRIPPIN is a life on mission.

TRIPPIN is a life of sharing Jesus.

TRIPPIN is the life of every Christ follower.

21 "...as the Father sent me, I send you." John 20:21 (MSG)

19 Therefore go and make disciples in all the nations, baptizing them into the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit,

20 and then teach these new disciples to obey all the commands I have given you; and be sure of this—that I am with you always, even to the end of the world." Matthew 28:19-20 (TLB)

7 Jesus called the Twelve to him, and sent them out in pairs... . Mark 6:7 (MSG)

1 The Lord chose seventy other disciples and sent them on ahead in pairs to all the towns and villages he planned to visit later. Luke 10:1 (TLB)

21 'Go out quickly into the streets and alleys of the town and bring in the poor, the crippled, the blind and the lame.'

22 " 'Sir,' the servant said, 'what you ordered has been done, but there is still room.'

23 "Then the master told his servant, 'Go out to the roads and country lanes and compel them to come in, so that my house will be full. Luke 14:21-23 (NIV)

I mention this because:

- A Christ follower is identified by who we "Know" and how we "Go".

What condition would the church be in if the ACTS church got their example from us?

When we talk about missions:

- We're not talking about a program, we're talking about a person.
- We're talking about sharing hope.
- We're talking about a mandate given to us, not others.

Missional living is sharing the love and story of Jesus wherever we are at.

Missional living is choosing the heart, and practices of a missionary in order to engage others with the gospel message.

Missional living means:

- Every Christ follower is a missionary.

- The gospel is central to everything we do.

For God loved the world so much that he gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life. God sent his Son into the world not to judge the world, but to save the world through him. John 3:16-17 (NLT)

Jesus, undeterred, went right ahead and gave his charge: "God authorized and commanded me to commission you: Go out and train everyone you meet, far and near, in this way of life, marking them by baptism in the threefold name: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. Then instruct them in the practice of all I have commanded you. I'll be with you as you do this, day after day after day, right up to the end of the age." Matthew 28:18-20 (MSG)

For the Son of Man came to seek and save those who are lost." Luke 19:10 (NLT)

"TRIPPIN" defines us as:

- Light to the world.

Matthew 5:14-16 (MSG)

- Witnesses to the world.

Acts 1:8 (NLT)

The heart of the Missional Life:

Matthew 9:35-38 (NLT)

- The Great commission requires great compassion.
- Compassion compels us to live and share the Good News.
- Compassion compels us to give.
- Compassion compels us to pray.

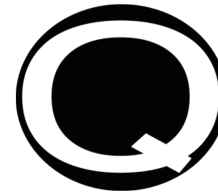
Questions for Connection Groups:
