

1 Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily entangles. And let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us, Hebrews 12:1 (NIV)

Spiritual Giant today is Joseph ...

As often happens:

- God didn't include the difficult details.
- God didn't include a <u>time table</u>.

Today's spiritual Giant would say: "Don't give up"

5 One night Joseph had a dream, and when he told his brothers about it, they hated him more than ever. 6 "Listen to this dream," he said. Genesis 37:5-6 (NLT)

7 "We were out in the field, tying up bundles of grain. Suddenly my bundle stood up, and your bundles all gathered around and bowed low before mine!" Genesis 37:7 (NLT)

19 "Here comes the dreamer!" they said. 20 "Come on, let's kill him and throw him into one of these cisterns. (Big pit) We can tell our father, 'A wild animal has eaten him.' Then we'll see what becomes of his dreams!" Genesis 37:19-20 (NLT)

Don't give up:

• Even if it doesn't start off well.

13...I focus on this one thing: Forgetting the past and looking forward to what lies ahead,.. Philippians 3:13 (NLT)

12 How thankful I am to Christ Jesus our Lord for choosing me as one of his messengers, and giving me the strength to be faithful to him, 13 even though I used to scoff at the name of Christ. I hunted down his people, harming them in every way I could. But God had mercy on me because I didn't know what I was doing, for I didn't know Christ at that time. 1 Timothy 1:12-13 (TLB)

• Even if those <u>closest</u> to <u>you</u> don't support you.

3 "He's just a carpenter, Mary's boy, and a brother of James and Joseph, Judas and Simon. And his sisters live right here among us." And they were offended! 4 Then Jesus told them, "A prophet is honored everywhere except in his hometown and among his relatives and by his own family." Mark 6:3-4 (TLB)

Even if your journey is full of <u>surprises</u>.

28 And <u>we know</u> that God causes everything to work together for the good of those who love God and are called according to his purpose for them. Romans 8:28 (NLT)

Even if it's taking a <u>long time</u> to realize it.

3 But these things I plan won't happen right away. Slowly, steadily, surely, the time approaches when the vision will be fulfilled. If it seems slow, do not despair, for these things will surely come to pass. Just be patient! They will not be overdue a single day! Habakkuk 2:3 (TLB)

Final words of encouragement:

• "Focus on what happening in you, not to you."

6 So be truly glad. There is wonderful joy ahead, even though you have to endure many trials for a little while.
7 These trials will show that your faith is genuine. It is being tested as fire tests and purifies gold—though your faith is far more precious than mere gold. So when your faith remains strong through many trials, it will bring you much praise and glory and honor on the day when Jesus Christ is revealed to the whole world. 1
Peter 1:6-7 (NLT)

2 ...consider it an opportunity for great joy. 3 For you know that when your faith is tested, your endurance has a chance to grow. James 1:2-3 (NLT)

• "Remember, Your response to offenses today will determine

your future."

20 You intended to harm me, but God intended it all for good... Genesis 50:20 (NLT)

"Count on it, there will be <u>setbacks</u>, but God is always faithful and God is always <u>with</u> <u>you</u>."
