

- 21 You can make many plans, but the Lord's purpose will prevail. Proverbs 19:21 (NLT)
- God has a <u>plan</u> and a <u>destination</u> for your life this year.

17 Don't act thoughtlessly, but understand what the Lord wants you to do. Ephesians 5:17 (NLT)

We need a clarity for life:

- That gives us <u>faith</u> in a powerful God.
- That gives us <u>guidance</u> from a personal God.
- That gives us <u>courage</u> from a present God.

Clarity happens:

• When we're not distracted by our <u>flesh</u>.

17 The Spirit and your desires are enemies of each other. They are always fighting each other and keeping you from doing what you feel you should. Galatians 5:17 (CEV)

• When we know when <u>God</u> is <u>speaking</u> to us.

27 My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me. John 10:27 (ESV) (Psalm 32:8 (NIV); Isaiah 30:21 (NET))

• When we're following the <u>Spirit's leading</u> in our life.

14 For all who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God. Romans 8:14 (ESV) 16 ...walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh. Galatians 5:16 (ESV)

Fasting brings clarity:

- It establishes what is <u>essential</u> in our lives.
- It deals with the distractions that dominates our lives.
- It corrects our <u>connection</u> to this world.

3 "Call to me, and I will answer you; I will tell you wonderful and marvelous things that you know nothing about. Jeremiah 33:3 (GNT)

• Prayer connects us to <u>God</u> and his <u>counsel</u>.

2 Because he turned his ear to me, I will call on him as long as I live. Psalm 116:2 (NIV)

GOD's there, listening for all who pray, for all who pray and mean it. Psalm 145:18 (MSG)

Our lack of <u>connection</u> with God reveals our lack of <u>faith</u> in God.

Prayer is simply: Our <u>conversation</u> with God. Real prayer is driven by relationship not need or crisis.

How prayer connects us to God:

- Draws us <u>close</u> to God.
- Gives us <u>confidence</u> in God.
- Allows us to live dependently on God.

Search me, O God, and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts. Point out anything in me that offends you, and lead me along the path of everlasting life. Psalm 139:23-24 (NLT)

How prayer brings clarity:

Prayer replaces worry.

Don't fret or worry. Instead of worrying, pray. Let petitions and praises shape your worries into prayers, letting God know your concerns. Philippians 4:6 (MSG)

• Prayer relinquishes <u>control</u>.

...by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. Philippians 4:6-7 (NIV)

• Prayer creates <u>contentment</u>.

The LORD is my shepherd; I have all that I need. Psalm 23:1 (NLT)

Prayer provides <u>confidence</u> in God.

I can do everything through him who gives me strength.Philippians 4:13

Prayer doesn't move God toward us. Prayer moves us toward God.
