# The Beatitudes:

- The Beatitudes describe the **<u>temperament</u>** of a Follower of Christ.
- The Beatitudes are not what we <u>do</u>, but who we <u>are</u>.
- They are attitudes we have as a result of our encounters with God.

1 Now when Jesus saw the crowds, he went up on a mountainside and sat down. His disciples came to him, 2 and he began to teach them, saying: 3 "Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. Matthew 5:1-3 (NIV)

## The Definition is:

"Blessed" - The attitude that exists because of God's favor or the mindset that comes from God's blessings.

3 "Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. Matthew 5:1-3 (NIV)

# The Poor in Spirit:

- Has nothing to do with <u>money</u>.
- Has nothing to do with **<u>degrading</u>** ourselves.
- To be Poor in Spirit means:
- I am helpless without God.
- I come to God realizing that I am <u>empty</u>.
- I am **inadequate** to resolve my spiritual condition.
- I am in desperate need of God.

"God blesses those who realize their need for him..." (NLT)

- "...who recognize they are spiritually helpless..." (GWT)
- "... who depend only on HIM ... " (CEV)
- "... who know they have great spiritual needs..." (NCV)

# • Our <u>sin</u> issue is a <u>pride</u> issue.

The LORD <u>detests</u> all the <u>proud of heart</u>. Be sure of this: They will not go <u>unpunished</u>. Proverbs 16:5 God opposes <u>the proud</u> but gives grace to <u>the humble</u>. 1 Peter 5:5

In the pride of his face the wicked does not seek him; all his thoughts are, "There is no God." Psalm 10:4 (ESV)

Some expressions of pride:

- I know what's <u>best</u> for <u>me</u>.
- I can handle this myself.

- I don't <u>need</u> you.
- I'm <u>Okay</u>.
- I'm better than others.
- 18 ... "No one is good--except God alone. Mark 10:18 (NIV)

•Humility recognizes that the only thing good in me is God in me.

- When we don't recognize that all we have is a gift from God, we set ourselves up to <u>be</u> God.
- When we don't admit that all we are is because of God, we tend to see ourselves as a gift **to** God.

He told his next story to some who were complacently pleased with themselves over their moral performance and looked down their noses at the common people: "Two men went up to the Temple to pray, one a Pharisee, the other a tax man. Luke 18:9-10 (MSG)

The Pharisee posed and prayed like this: 'Oh, God, I thank you that I am not like other people—robbers, crooks, adulterers, or, heaven forbid, like this tax man. I fast twice a week and tithe on all my income.' Luke 18:11-12 (MSG)

# • When we are full of **ourselves**, there is no room for <u>God</u>.

13 "But the tax collector stood at a distance and dared not even lift his eyes to heaven as he prayed. Instead, he beat his chest in sorrow, saying, 'O God, be merciful to me, for I am a sinner.' Luke 18:13 (NLT)

## Humility is willing to do what pride will not.

14 I tell you, this sinner, not the Pharisee, returned home justified before God. For those who exalt themselves will be humbled, and those who humble themselves will be exalted." Luke 18:14 (NLT)

"You're blessed when you're at the end of your rope. With less of you there is more of God and his rule." Matthew 5:3 (MSG)

## How is poverty in Spirit developed?

- Don't make yourself more than you are.
- Don't make God less than He is.
