

Definition of Essential: Absolutely Necessary; extremely important

To God, you are essential.

Your **priorities** define what is essential in your life.

- Priorities are more than a list in our head; priorities are about what we do first.
- Priorities are about <u>how</u> we <u>engage</u> in what we value.
 One of the teachers of religion who was standing there listening to the discussion realized that Jesus had answered well. So he asked, "Of all the commandments, which is the most important?" Mark 12:28 (TLB)

...love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, all your mind, and all your strength.' The second is equally important: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.'... Mark 12:30-31 (NLT)

This is essential:

Love <u>God</u> completely and love <u>others</u> intentionally.

Loving God completely means:

• We're taking steps to become **completely His.**

Come close to God, and God will come close to you. Wash your hands, you sinners; <u>purify</u> your hearts, for your loyalty is <u>divided between God and the world</u>. James 4:8 (NLT)

• Reorder our lives to show that God has first place.

"I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery. "You shall have no other gods before me. Exodus 20:2-3 (NIV)

In putting God first:

We give God the first of everything.

A Tithe = A tenth; The first and the best

A tithe of <u>everything</u> from the land, whether grain from the soil or fruit from the trees, belongs to the LORD; <u>it is holy to the LORD</u>. Leviticus 27:30 (NIV)

The purpose of tithing is to teach you always to put God first in your lives. Deuteronomy 14:23 (TLB)

We give God:

• The first of my year with <u>prayer</u> and <u>fasting</u>.

Prayer **connects** us to **God**.

Fasting disconnects us from the world.

• The first of my month with my <u>tithe</u>.

Bring your full tithe to the Temple treasury so there will be ample provisions in my Temple. Test me in this and see if I don't open up heaven itself to you and pour out blessings beyond your wildest dreams. Malachi 3:10 (MSG)

"You can't worship two gods at once. Loving one god, you'll end up hating the other. Adoration of one feeds contempt for the other. You can't worship God and Money both. Matthew 6:24 (MSG)

• The first of our week with my worship.

Let's see how inventive we can be in encouraging love and helping out, <u>not avoiding</u> worshiping together as some do but spurring each other on, especially as we see the big

Day approaching. Hebrews 10:24-25 (MSG)

• The first of my day with my **time**.

Time in the **Bible**.

Time in worship.

Time in **prayer**.

When we put God First:

Expect God to bless the rest.

Listen for GOD's voice in everything you do, everywhere you go; he's the one who will keep you on track. Don't assume that you know it all. Run to GOD! Run from evil! Your body will glow with health, your very bones will vibrate with life! Honor GOD with everything you own; give him the first and the best. Your barns will burst, your wine vats will brim over. Proverbs 3:6-10 (MSG)
