...let your good deeds shine out for all to see, so that everyone will praise your heavenly Father. Matthew 5:16 (NLT)

Is the **<u>church</u>** God wants us to be reflected in the **<u>people</u>** we aspire to be?

...go and make followers of all people in the world... Matthew 28:19 (NCV)

God's mission reminds us:

Jesus is with you <u>always</u>.

And be sure of this: I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Matthew 28:20 (NLT) How we uniquely accomplish the mission is what we call our **Vision.**

• The vision unites us.

Unity in the church begins to erode the moment our focus gets away from <u>Jesus</u>. And when it comes to the church, he (Jesus) organizes and holds it together, like a head does a body. Colossians 1:18b (MSG)

- The vision directs us.
- The vision inspires us.
- The vision protects us.

Where there is no vision, the people perish... Proverbs 29:18 (KJV)

Our vision is so important:

"When I don't buy into the vision, church becomes about me."

Two questions our vision answers:

• Why does the Quest exist?

To <u>creatively love</u> and <u>lead</u> people a growing relationship with <u>Jesus</u>.

The Vision requires <u>creativity</u>.

Even though I am free of the demands and expectations of everyone, I have voluntarily become a servant to any and all in order to reach a wide range of people: religious, nonreligious, meticulous moralists, loose-living immoralists, the defeated, the demoralized—whoever. I didn't take on their way of life. I kept my bearings in Christ—but I entered their world and tried to experience things from their point of view. I've become just about every sort of servant there is in my attempts to lead those I meet into a God-saved life. I did all this because of the Message. I didn't just want to talk about it; I wanted to be in on it! 1 Corinthians 9:19-23 (MSG) 22 ...I try to find common ground with everyone, doing everything I can to save some.

I, too, try to please everyone in everything I do. I don't just do what is best for me; I do what is best for others so that many may be saved. And you should imitate me, just as I imitate Christ. 1 Corinthians 10:33-11:1 (NLT)

The Vision demands Love.

So we love **God** completely and love **people** creatively.

Jesus replied, "'You must love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, and all your mind.' This is the first and greatest commandment. A second is equally important: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' Matthew 22:37-39 (NLT)

- Love will call us to give up what is important to us for what benefits others.
- The Vision inspires us to lead.

Follow my example, as I follow the example of Christ. 1 Corinthians 11:1 (NIV)

- ... You paid careful attention to the way we lived among you, and determined to live that way yourselves. In imitating us, you imitated the Master... 1 Thessalonians 1:5-6 (MSG)
- We can't lead others where we are not willing to go.

Another question our vision answers is:

- Why should the Quest exist?
- ..."Go into all the world and preach the Good News to everyone. Anyone who believes and is baptized will be saved. But anyone who refuses to believe will be condemned. Mark 16:15-16 (NLT)

Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life, but whoever rejects the Son will not see life, for God's wrath remains on them. John 3:36 (NIV)

The thief's purpose is to steal, kill and destroy. My purpose is to give life in all its fullness. John 10:10 (TLB)

Why the stakes are high:

- Time is short and eternity is long.
- People are living without <u>hope</u>.
- People are <u>hurting</u>.
- Our friends need an environment like the Quest.
- You have been given the vision, run with it.

13 For "Everyone who calls on the name of the LORD will be saved."
