

I'm telling you, once and for all, that unless you return to square one and start over like children, you're not even going to get a look at the kingdom, let alone get in. - It's in the simple life of <u>trusting</u> God that we experience the wonder of God.

 I pray that the God who gives hope will fill you with much joy and peace while you trust in him... Romans 15:13 (NCV)
- The wonder of God allows us to live in the **moment**, not the **past**.

The challenge we face:

- If we don't live with the wonder of God we can't know the **peace** of God.
- Peace in life comes from the presence of **Jesus** in our life.

Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts... Collisions 3:15 (NIV)

Let the peace that Christ gives control your thinking... Collisions 3:15 (NCV)

13 Suddenly, the angel was joined by a vast host of others—the armies of heaven—praising God and saying, "Glory to God in highest heaven, and peace on earth to those with whom God is pleased." Luke 2:10-14 ...And he will be their peace. Micah 5:5

An important message for us to understand:

• Jesus came to enter our chaos and establish peace.

Peace means a couple of things:

Peace is not just the <u>absence</u> of something, but also the **presence** of something better.

- ...And he will be their peace. Micah 5:4-5
- The greater the **chaos** the more **alone** we feel.

23 "The virgin will become pregnant and give birth to a son, and they will name him Immanuel," which means "God is with us." Matthew 1:23 (GWT)

Real Peace is experienced:

When we surrender ourselves to Christ.

This is the message of Good News ...that there is peace with God through Jesus Christ, $\underline{\text{who is Lord}}$ of all. Acts 10:36

The peace you can experience this Christmas...

- Peace with God.
- 19 ... <u>God was</u> in Christ <u>making peace between the world and himself</u>, not putting their sins to their account, and having given to us the preaching of this <u>news of peace</u>. 2 Corinthians 5:19 (BBE)
- 1 ...since we have been made right in God's sight by faith, we have peace with God because of what Jesus Christ our Lord has done for us. Romans 5:1 (NLT)
- Peace with Yourself.

15 Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts... Colossians 3:15 (NIV)

5 Only God gives inward peace, and I depend on him. Psalm 62:5

Peace with Others.

16 ...Christ reconciled both groups to God by means of his death on the cross, and <u>our hostility toward each other was put to death</u>." Ephesians 2:16 (NLT)

You can't give what you don't possess.

To experience God's peace:

•Accept God's gift to you.

I am leaving you with a gift—peace of mind and heart. And the peace I give is a gift the world cannot give. So don't be troubled or afraid. John. 14:27

Don't live in the past.

If we confess our sins, he [God] is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness. 1 John 1:9 (NIV)

• Let go of resentment.

So I want men everywhere to pray with holy hands lifted up to God, free from sin and anger and resentment. 1 Timothy 2:8

Don't waste time on what you can't <u>change</u>.

If we confess our sins, he [God] is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness. 1 John 1:9 (NIV)

People who conceal their sins will not prosper, but if they confess and turn from them, they will receive mercy. Proverbs 28:13 (NLT)

Put your <u>trust</u> in the one that is <u>bigger</u> than yourself.

I find rest in God; only He can save me. He is my rock and my salvation. He is my defender; I will not be defeated. Psalms 62:1-2 (NCV)
