

Resolution: A decision to do or not do something.

Revolution: To forcibly/intentionally overthrow the authority that controls our lives.

- A revolution in our lives requires new **leadership** for our lives.
- New leadership in our lives changes the **purpose** of our lives.

We know that our old life died with Christ on the cross so that our sinful selves would have no power over us and we would not be slaves to sin. Anyone who has died with Christ is made free from sin's control. Romans 6:6-7 (NCV)

That means you must not give sin a vote in the way you conduct your lives. Don't give it the time of day. Don't even run little errands that are connected with that old way of life. Throw yourselves wholeheartedly and full-time—remember, you've been raised from the dead!—into God's way of doing things. Sin can't tell you how to live. After all, <u>you're not living under that old tyranny any longer. You're living in the freedom of God</u>. Romans 6:12-14 (MSG)

- A spiritual revolution will require us to <u>come close to God</u>.
- 5 ...God has said, "Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you." Hebrews 13:5 (NIV)

Come close to God, and God will come close to you... James 4:8 (NLT)

But as for me, I get as close to him as I can! I have chosen him, and I will tell everyone about the wonderful ways he rescues me. Psalm 73:28 (TLB)

Coming close to God means:

Coming close to God means we're all in.

Come close to God, and God will come close to you. Wash your hands, you sinners; purify your hearts, for your loyalty is divided between God and the world. James 4:8 (NLT)

• We need **prayer life** that connects us to God's life.

For I know the plans I have for you," says the Lord. "They are plans for good and not for disaster, to give you a future and a hope. Jerimiah 29:11 (NLT)

In those days when you pray, I will listen. If you look for me wholeheartedly, you will find me. Jerimiah 29:12-13 (NLT)

<u>Fasting</u> that disconnects us from the <u>world</u>.

When you fast:

- You're not manipulating God, but <u>surrendering</u> to God.
- Ask <u>God</u> what you should <u>fast</u>.
- Expect <u>results</u>.

6Anyone who wants to come to him must believe that God exists and that he rewards those who sincerely seek him. Hebrews 11:6 (NLT)

• Make God your greatest <u>priority</u>.

let us come near to God with a sincere heart and a sure faith, because we have been made free from a guilty conscience, and our bodies have been washed with pure water. Hebrews 10:22 (NCV)
