- Worship allows us to be **present** in His presence.
- An **encounter** with God changes everything.

Song: **Goodness of God** (Bethel Music)

15 I cannot count the times when you have faithfully rescued me from danger. I will tell everyone how good you are, and of your constant, daily care. 16 I walk in the strength of the Lord God. I tell everyone that you alone are just and good. Psalm 71:15-16 (TLB)

- Your relationship with God is personal, not **private**.

Worship is not a part of the Christian's **life**; it is the Christian's **life**.

Give thanks to the LORD, for he is good! His faithful love endures forever. Psalm 106:1 (NLT)

13 If we are unfaithful, he (God) remains faithful because he cannot be untrue to himself. 2 Timothy 2:13 (GWT)

God's goodness:

- ...is not **limited** by my **failures**.

15 But you, O Lord, are a merciful and loving God, always patient, always kind and faithful. Psalm 86:15 (TEV)

- ...is often revealed in my **darkest hour**.

28 LORD, you give light to my lamp. My God brightens the darkness around me. Psalm 18:28 (NCV)

4 Even when I walk through the darkest valley, I will not be afraid, for you are close beside me. Your rod and your staff protect and comfort me. Psalm 23:4 (NLT)

7 Where could I go to escape from you? Where could I get away from your presence? Psalm 139:7 (TEV)

“There is nothing you can do about being present with God, but it's up to you whether you benefit from His presence.” *Levi Lusko*

8 Find out for yourself how good the LORD is. Happy are those who find safety with him. Psalm 34:8 (TEV)

- ...is experienced in His **forgiveness** of my **sin**.

8 But God showed his great love for us by sending Christ to die for us while we were still sinners. Romans 5:8 (TLB)

Questions that can be used in Connection Groups:

These questions also work well for personal time with God.

- What scripture and/or point spoke most to you from the Talk on Sunday? Why?

- How does an encounter with God change everything?
- When you think about God's goodness, do you think primarily about the things He does for you or what He doesn't do that you deserve?
- Do you think our response to God's goodness affects our connection with God? Explain.

- How do you respond to the goodness of God? (Do you keep it to yourself or share with others what God has done?)

- When you recall God's presence helping you in your darkest hour, what is the emotion you feel? Can you share a time when God came through for you in a difficult time?
- Discuss how God's goodness is displayed in forgiving our sins? When you think of God forgiving you, what is the emotion you feel? What is your response to His forgiveness?
