

What Jesus has provided for you doesn't need to scare you.

I will ask the Father and he will give you another Comforter, and he will never leave you. He is the Holy Spirit, the Spirit who leads into all truth. The world at large cannot receive him, for it isn't looking for him and doesn't recognize him. But you do, for he lives with you now and someday will be in you. John 14:16-17 (TLB)

The Holy Spirit has always been a part of God's activity in the world.

The earth was formless and empty, and darkness covered the deep waters. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the surface of the waters. Genesis 1:2

Samson went down to Timnah with his father and mother. ... suddenly a young lion came roaring toward him. The Spirit of the Lord came powerfully upon him so that he tore the lion apart with his bare hands... Judges 14:5-6

Getting to know the Holy Spirit:

The Holy Spirit comes into our lives when we put our <u>faith</u> in Jesus.

And when you believed in Christ, he identified you as his own by giving you the Holy Spirit, whom he promised long ago. Ephesians 1:13

God is the One who makes you and us strong in Christ. God made us his chosen people. He put his mark on us to show that we are his, and he put his Spirit in our hearts to be a guarantee for all he has promised. 2 Corinthians 1:21-22

The Holy Spirit is a person, not a thing.

The world at large cannot receive <u>him</u>, for it isn't looking for <u>him</u> and doesn't recognize him. But you do, for he lives with you now and some day shall be in you. John 14:17 (TLB)

And do not bring sorrow to God's Holy Spirit by the way you live. Remember, he has identified you as his own, guaranteeing that you will be saved on the day of redemption. Ephesians 4:30 (NLT)

We are to have relationship with the Spirit.

(May)The amazing grace of the Master, Jesus Christ, the extravagant love of God, the intimate friendship of the Holy Spirit, be with all of you. 2 Corinthians 13:14 (MSG)

The Holy Spirit is <u>comforting</u>, not <u>creepy</u>.

I will ask the Father and he will give you another Comforter.. John 14:6 (TLB)

• The Holy Spirit is **God**.

But Peter said, "Ananias, why has Satan filled your heart to lie to the Holy Spirit ... you have not lied to men but to God." Acts 5:3-4 (MSG)

The Holy Spirit is **necessary** in our lives.

Don't grieve God. Don't break his heart. His Holy Spirit, moving and breathing in you, is the most intimate part of your life, making you fit for himself. Don't take such a gift for granted. Ephesians 4:30 (MSG)

Why we need the Holy Spirit:

I cannot serve God without Him.

And because you belong to him, the power of the life-giving Spirit has freed you from the power of sin that leads to death.

Romans 8:2 (NLT)

For if you live according to the flesh, you will die; but if by the Spirit you put to death the misdeeds of the body, you will live. Romans 8:13 (NIV)

To share **Jesus** with others.

My message and my preaching were not with wise and persuasive words, but with a <u>demonstration of the Spirit's power</u>, so that your faith might not rest on men's wisdom, but on God's power. 1 Corinthians 2:4-5

But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you. And you will be my witnesses, telling people about me everywhere—in Jerusalem, throughout Judea, in Samaria, and to the ends of the earth. Acts 1:8 (NLT)

For when you are weak.

In the same way, the Spirit <u>helps us in our weakness</u>. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but <u>the Spirit himself intercedes for us</u> with groans that words cannot express. Romans 8:26

To have **hope** in a hopeless world.

May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit. Romans 15:13




TO CREATIVELY LOVE AND LEAD PEOPLE IN A GROWING RELATIONSHIP WITH JESUS.
