Make the most of every opportunity in these evil days. <u>Don't act thoughtlessly</u>, <u>but understand what the Lord wants you to do</u>. Ephesians 5:15-17 It pays to <u>take life seriously</u>; things work out when you trust in God. Proverbs 16:20 (MSG)

A deceived faith is a belief in God without surrender to God.

You believe that there is one God. Good! Even the demons believe that--and shudder. James 2:19

A deceived faith has knowledge about God but no **change** from God.

God designed you to grow spiritually.

For from the very beginning God decided that those who came to him—and all along he knew who would—should become like his Son.. Romans 8:29 (TLB)

Spiritual Growth is a **natural** process for every Christ follower.

"It's natural" doesn't mean:

• Doesn't mean it happens without our attention.

Truth is:

Spiritual growth is a **partnership** project.

Work hard to show the results of your salvation, obeying God with deep reverence and fear. For God is working in you, giving you the desire and the power to do what pleases him. Philippians 2:12-13 (NLT)

Truth is:

God works in, we work out.

Doesn't mean it happens instantly.

Truth is:

It's a process that takes time.

And now just as you trusted Christ to save you, trust him, too, for each day's problems; live in vital union with him. Let your roots grow down into him and draw up nourishment from him. See that you go on growing in the Lord, and become strong and vigorous in the truth you were taught. Let your lives overflow with joy and thanksgiving for all he has done. Don't let others spoil your faith and joy with their philosophies, their wrong and shallow answers built on men's thoughts and ideas, instead of what Christ has said. Colossians 2:6-8 (TLB)

• Doesn't mean it happens constantly.

And I am certain that God, who began the good work within you, will continue his work until it is finally finished on the day when Christ Jesus returns. Philippians 1:6 (NLT)

Spiritual Growth is:

- Growth is the process of discipleship.
- Growth is also the process of becoming.

For from the very beginning God decided that those who came to him—and all along he knew who would—should become like his Son... Romans 8:29 (TLB)

• When we prioritize the process, it leads us to the goal.

The goal is becoming more like **Jesus**.

For from the very beginning God decided that those who came to him...<u>should become like his Son</u>... Romans 8:29 (TLB)

Growth comes in many ways:

Growth can come from revelation.

And when God is personally present, a living Spirit, that old, constricting legislation is recognized as obsolete. We're free of it! All of us! Nothing between us and God, <u>our faces shining with the brightness of his face</u>. And so we are transfigured much like the Messiah, our lives gradually becoming brighter and more beautiful <u>as God enters our lives and we become like him</u>. 2 Corinthians 3:17-18 (MSG)

Growth can come because it's forced on us.

Consider it a sheer gift, friends, when tests and challenges come at you from all sides. You know that under pressure, your faith-life is forced into the open and shows its true colors. So don't try to get out of anything prematurely. Let it do its work so you become mature and well-developed, not deficient in any way. James 1:2-4 (MSG)

Difficult times develop us.

...you need more than faith; you must also work hard to be good, and even that is not enough. For then you must learn to know God better and discover what he wants you to do. Next, learn to put aside your own desires so that you will become patient and godly, gladly letting God have his way with you. This will make possible the next step, which is for you to enjoy other people and to like them, and finally you will grow to love them deeply. The more you go on in this way, the more you will grow strong spiritually and become fruitful and useful to our Lord Jesus Christ. 2 Peter 1:5-8 (TLB)

Action steps for spiritual growth:

- Open your heart to God.
- ...learn to know God better and discover what he wants you to do. 2 Peter 1:5 (TLB)

• Surrender yourself to God.

Next, learn to put aside your own desires so that you will become patient and godly, gladly letting God have his way with you. 2 Peter 1:6 (TLB)

Open your heart to others.

This will make possible the next step, which is for you to enjoy other people and to like them, and finally you will grow to love them deeply. 2 Peter 1:7 (TLB)

Keep your eyes on *Jesus*, who both began and finished this race we're in. <u>Study how he did it</u>. Because he never lost sight of where he was headed—that exhilarating finish in and with God... Hebrews 12:2-3 (MSG)
