

 Faith is not always about what I can <u>get</u> from God but what I can give to God.

I plead with you to give your bodies to God because of all he has done for you. Let them be a living and holy sacrifice—the kind he will find acceptable. This is truly the way to worship him. Romans 12:1 (NLT)

Our faith in Jesus leads us to worship Jesus.

When the angels had returned to heaven, the shepherds said to each other, "Let's go to Bethlehem! Let's see this thing that has happened, which the Lord has told us about." They hurried to the village and found Mary and Joseph. And there was the baby, lying in the manger. After seeing him, the shepherds told everyone what had happened and what the angel had said to them about this child. All who heard the shepherds' story were astonished, but Mary kept all these things in her heart and thought about them often. The shepherds went back to their flocks, glorifying and praising God for all they had heard and seen. It was just as the angel had told them. Luke 2:15-20 (NLT)

• We need to make **time** to **worship** Jesus.

"Where is the newborn king of the Jews? We saw his star as it rose, and <u>we have come to worship him."</u> Matthew 2:2 (NLT)

The shepherds went back to their flocks, <u>glorifying and praising God</u> for all they had heard and seen. It was just as the angel had told them. Luke 2:20 (NLT)

They entered the house and saw the child with his mother, Mary, and they bowed down and worshiped him... Matthew 2:11 (NLT)

Why worship is important:

Expresses my <u>affection</u> to God.

The Master said: "These people make a big show of saying the right thing, but their hearts aren't in it. Because they act like they're worshiping me but don't mean it." Isaiah 29:13 (MSG)

Focuses my <u>attention</u> on God.

But the time is coming—indeed it's here now—when true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and in truth. The Father is looking for those who will worship him that way. For God is Spirit, so those who worship him must worship in spirit and in truth. John 4:23-24 (NLT)

Articulates my Awe of God.

Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, let us be thankful, and so worship God acceptably with reverence and awe, for our "God is a consuming fire." Hebrews 12:28-29 (NIV)

Then the eleven disciples left for Galilee, going to the mountain where Jesus had told them to go. When they saw him, they worshiped him—but some of them doubted! Matthew 28:16-17 (NLT)

Action Step:

- Get <u>away</u> with <u>God</u>.
- Open your **heart** to God.
- Make some <u>time</u> to <u>worship</u> God.
