

- The church is not a place of worship, but the **people who worship** God together.
- A healthy church does the right things for the right reasons.

Why we do what we do:

- Worship to express to God how much we love him.
- Discipleship to help us <u>become</u> more like Jesus.
- Fellowship to <u>love</u> each other more deeply.
- Ministry to allow the Holy Spirit to use us to meet people's needs.
- Evangelism to help people discover Jesus.

The actions of the church are defined by 3 things:

• The standard we choose to live by.

The **<u>Bible</u>** is our standard to live by.

Every part of Scripture is God-breathed and useful one way or another—showing us truth, exposing our rebellion, correcting our mistakes, training us to live God's way. 2 Timothy 3:16 (MSG)

The <u>vision</u> we choose to live out.

A vision gives you a **<u>purpose</u>** to live out.

Where there is no vision, the people are uncontrolled; but he who keeps the law will be happy. Proverbs 29:18 (BBE)

• The <u>Values</u> we choose to live with.

All the believers devoted themselves to the <u>apostles' teaching</u>, and to <u>fellowship</u>, and to <u>sharing in meals</u> (including the Lord's Supper), and to <u>prayer</u>. Acts 2:42 (NLT)

And all the believers <u>met together in one place</u> and <u>shared everything</u> they had. They sold their property and possessions and <u>shared the money with those in need</u>. They <u>worshiped together</u> at the Temple each day, <u>met in homes for the Lord's Supper</u>, and <u>shared their meals with great joy and generosity</u>—

all the while <u>praising God</u> and enjoying the goodwill of all the people. And each day the Lord added to their fellowship those who were being saved. Acts 2:44-47 (NLT)

Values give you **priorities** to live with.

If we don't understand why we do what we do:

- In time we will do something different.
- In time we will do what is <u>easy</u>.

Our vision: To creatively love and lead people in a growing relationship with Jesus.

Some of our values:

We <u>care</u> about <u>people</u>.

When he saw the crowds, he felt sorry for them because they were hurting and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd. Matthew 9:36 (NCV)

• Lost **people** are our passion.

"For the Son of Man came to seek and to save the lost." Luke 19:10 (NIV)

• Encountering God changes lives.

"For where two or three gather together as my followers, I am there among them." Matthew 18:20 (NLT)

When we meet together it's an opportunity to:

• Feel **Loved** by others.

"This is how everyone will recognize that you are my disciples—when they see the love you have for each other." John 13:35 (MSG)

• Experience **<u>God</u>** for ourselves.

This is how we do it:

• We show up with our heart engaged.

"These people make a big show of saying the right thing, but their hearts aren't in it. Because they act like they're worshiping me but don't mean it..." Isaiah 29:13 (MSG)

• We show up ready to **love** people.

Let love be your highest goal!.. 1 Corinthians 14:1 (NLT)

• Show up **anticipating** an encounter with God.

...rejoice, you who worship the LORD. <u>Search for the LORD and for his strength; continually seek him.</u> Remember the wonders he has performed, his miracles, and the rulings he has given... Psalm 105:3-5 (NLT)
