

- Paul wants this letter to equip us for the new lives God has for us.
- We have to learn to surrender our **thoughts** to the Holy Spirit.

...and we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ. 2 Corinthians 10:5 (NIV)

...let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think. Romans 12:2 (NLT) So letting your sinful nature control your mind leads to death. But letting the Spirit control your mind leads to life and peace. Romans 8:6 (NLT)

• Every Christ follower needs to be controlled by the Holy Spirit.

7 For the sinful nature is always hostile to God. It never did obey God's laws, and it never will... 8 That's why those who are still under the control of their sinful nature can never please God. 9 But you are not controlled by your sinful nature. You are controlled by the Spirit if you have the Spirit of God living in you. Romans 8:7-9 (NLT)

Don't be drunk with wine, because that will ruin your life. Instead, be filled with the Holy Spirit... Ephesians 5:18 (NLT)

Being filled with the Holy Spirit:

- To be Under His Control.
- The Spirit-controlled life is not a one-time event.

And the disciples were continually filled with joy and with the Holy Spirit. Acts 13:52 (NASB)

Barriers to a Spirit-controlled life:

- When feelings run our lives.
- The cares and distractions of this world

Give all your worries and cares to God, for he cares about you. 1 Peter 5:7 (NLT)

The fear of not having <u>control</u>.

To experience a Spirit-controlled life:

Continually <u>surrender</u> ourselves to the Holy Spirit.

How we surrender:

- Ask for Him to **lead** you every day.
- Stop fighting him.

Don't you realize that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit, who lives in you and was given to you by God? You do not belong to yourself...1 Corinthians 6:19 (NLT)

• Embrace your new life and purpose

Marks of a Spirit-controlled life:

• The fruits of the spirit are noticeable in me.

But the Holy Spirit produces this kind of fruit in our lives: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. Galatians 5:22:23 (NLT)

• We're not acting out of our sinful nature.
