Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship. 2 Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will. Romans 12:1-2 (NIV)

Question One:

- What does it mean to be a living sacrifice?
- Moment by moment we're doing whatever <u>God wants</u>.

I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me. Galatians 2:20 (NIV)

Question Two:

- What does it mean to be conformed to the pattern of this world?
- I take my values, standards, and priorities from the world around me.

The values, standards, and priorities of this world reflect Satan's lies.

1 Once you were under God's curse, doomed forever for your sins. 2 <u>You went along with the crowd</u> and were just like all the others, full of sin, <u>obeying Satan</u>, the mighty prince of the power of the air, who is at work right now in the hearts of those who are against the Lord. 3 <u>All of us used to be just as they are</u>, our lives expressing the evil within us, doing every wicked thing that our passions or our evil thoughts might lead us into. Ephesians 2:1-3

Question Three:

- What does it mean to **<u>renew your mind</u>**?
- I align my values, standards, and priorities with <u>scripture</u>.

31...Jesus said, "If you hold to my teaching, you are really my disciples. 32 Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free." John 8:31-32

To be changed from the inside out:

- It starts with a decision to give God <u>permission</u>.
- Input always determines output.

What do I watch and read?

Who do I hang out with?

Become wise by walking with the wise; hang out with fools and watch your life fall to pieces. Proverbs 13:20

Don't hang out with angry people; don't keep company with hotheads. Bad temper is contagious— don't get infected. Proverbs 22:24-25

• Flee what's harmful, feed what's helpful.

Run from anything that stimulates youthful lusts. Instead, pursue righteous living, faithfulness, love, and peace. Enjoy the companionship of those who call on the Lord with pure hearts. 2 Timothy 2:22

• The gospel produces in us a mind that is <u>set</u> on God and <u>satisfied</u> with God.
