• We belong in **Spiritual Community**.

5 ...so in Christ we, though many, form one body, <u>and each member belongs to all the others</u>. 6 We have different gifts... Romans 12:5-6 (NIV)

9 Love must be sincere. Hate what is evil; cling to what is good. 10 Be devoted to one another in love. Honor one another above yourselves. 11 Never be lacking in zeal, but keep your spiritual fervor, serving the Lord. 12 Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer. 13 Share with the Lord's people who are in need. • Love must define our spiritual community.

7 Dear friends, let us love one another, for love comes from God. <u>Everyone who loves has been born of God</u> and <u>knows God</u>. 8 Whoever does not love does not know God, because God is love. 1 John 4:8 35 By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another. John 13:35

Love is not:

Love is not a <u>feeling</u> or an <u>emotion</u>.

Love is:

Love is a <u>choice</u> followed by an <u>action</u>.

God showed how much he loved us by sending his one and only Son into the world so that we might have eternal life through him. 1 John 4:9

A gospel-shaped love in Spiritual Community:

9 Love must be sincere. Romans 12:9a

Our love is genuine.

"Make allowance for each other's faults, and forgive anyone who offends you. Remember, the Lord forgave you, so you must forgive others. Above all, clothe yourselves with love, which binds us all together in perfect harmony." Colossians 3:13-14 (NLT)

When your love is not sincere:

Choose to love and <u>repent</u> of the feelings within.

...Hate what is evil; cling to what is good. Romans 12:9b

• Our love looks for the good and rejects what is evil.

Despise evil; pursue what is good as if your life depends on it. Romans 12:9b (Voice)

All who fear the Lord will hate evil. Therefore, I hate pride and arrogance, corruption and perverse speech. Proverbs 8:13

You who love the Lord, hate evil! Psalm 97:10

This is key:

What we say and do must **<u>communicate</u>** truth and love.

10 Be devoted to one another in love. Honor one another above yourselves. Romans 12:10

• Our love feels like **family**.

We are committed to caring for each other.

11 Never be lacking in zeal, but keep your spiritual fervor, serving the Lord. 12 Be joyful in hope, patient in affliction, faithful in prayer. Romans 12:11-12

Our love is filled with the <u>expectancy</u> of God's activity.

1 We who are strong in the faith ought to help the weak to carry their burdens... Romans 15:1

13 Share with the Lord's people who are in need. Practice hospitality. Romans 12:13

• Our love expresses itself in **tangible** actions.
