

• Consistent small choices keep us true to a desired direction.

Wise choices will watch over you. Understanding will keep you safe. Proverbs 2:11 (NLT)

The challenges we face:

- Our choices tend to be inconsistent.
- Our choices are <u>emotional</u> responses.
- I choose to <u>grow</u> spiritually.
- 11 Now these are the gifts Christ gave to the church: the apostles, prophets, evangelists, pastors, and teachers.
- 12 Their responsibility is to equip God's people to do his work and build up the church, the body of Christ.
- 13 This will continue until we all come to such unity in our faith and knowledge of God's Son that we will be mature in the Lord, measuring up to the full and complete standard of Christ. Ephesians 4:11-13

He is the one we proclaim, admonishing and teaching everyone with all wisdom, <u>so that we may present</u> everyone fully mature in Christ. Colossians 1:28

Therefore let us leave the elementary doctrine of Christ and go on to maturity. Hebrews 6:1

- We all need to grow.
- God designed you to grow spiritually.

For from the very beginning God decided that those who came to him—and all along he knew who would—should become like his Son... Romans 8:29 (TLB)

Spiritual Growth is a **natural** process for every Christ follower.

Natural doesn't mean:

• Doesn't mean it happens without our attention.

Truth is:

Spiritual growth is a **partnership** project.

Work hard to show the results of your salvation, obeying God with deep reverence and fear. For God is working in you, giving you the desire and the power to do what pleases him. Philippians 2:12-13 (NLT)

God works in us, and we act on His leading.

Natural doesn't mean:

Doesn't mean it happens instantly.

Truth is:

It is a process that takes **time**.

6 And now just as you trusted Christ to save you, trust him, too, for each day's problems; live in vital union with him. 7 Let your roots grow down into him and draw up nourishment from him. See that you go on growing in the Lord, and become strong and vigorous in the truth you were taught. Let your lives overflow with joy and thanksgiving for all he has done. 8 Don't let others spoil your faith and joy with their philosophies, their wrong and shallow answers built on men's thoughts and ideas, instead of what Christ has said. Colossians 2:6-8 (TLB)

Natural doesn't mean:

• Doesn't mean it happens constantly.

6 And I am certain that God, who began the good work within you, will continue his work until it is finally finished on the day when Christ Jesus returns. Philippians 1:6 (NLT)

Spiritual Growth is:

Growth is the process of practicing <u>obedience</u>.

Don't fool yourself into thinking that you are a listener when you are anything but, letting the Word go in one ear and out the other. Act on what you hear! James 1:22-23

Growth is also the process of <u>becoming</u>.

The goal of maturity:

Becoming more like Jesus.

...(WE) should become like his Son... Romans 8:29 (TLB)

Our plan for Maturity:

- Respond to God with obedience.
- Commit to God that you will partner with Him.
- Schedule **spiritual disciplines** in your life.
- Commit to spiritual community for accountability.
