

# • God is at work creating faithfulness in you.

But the Holy Spirit produces this kind of fruit in our lives: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, <u>faithfulness</u>, 23 gentleness, and self-control. Galatians 5:22-23 (NLT)

# • God's faithfulness to us creates **hope** within us.

23 Let us hold unswervingly to the hope we profess, for he who promised is faithful. Hebrews 10:23 (NIV)

• God's love for you is always expressed in His faithfulness to you.

For the Lord is always good. He is always loving and kind, and his faithfulness goes on and on to each succeeding generation. Psalm 100:5 (TLB)

• What God has done for others in the past, He will also do for you.

# Ways God is faithful:

#### • God is faithful to keep his promises.

Let's keep a firm grip on the promises that keep us going. <u>He (God) always keeps his word</u>. Hebrews 10:23 (MSG)

God is not a man, so he does not lie. He is not human, so he does not change his mind. Has he ever spoken and failed to act? Has he ever promised and not carried it through? Numbers 23:19 (NLT)

### • God is faithful in his love and **<u>compassion</u>** for you.

..his compassion never ends. It is only the Lord's mercies that have kept us from complete destruction. Great is his faithfulness; his loving-kindness begins afresh each day. Lamentations 3:22-23

### • God is faithful in times of trial or temptation.

God is faithful; he will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, <u>he will also</u> provide a way out so that you can stand up under it. 1 Corinthians 10:13

### • God is faithful to prepare you for heaven.

Now may the God of peace make you holy in every way, and may your whole spirit and soul and body be kept blameless until our Lord Jesus Christ comes again. God will make this happen, for he who calls you is faithful. 1 Thessalonians 5:23-24

### • God is faithful to **protect** you from the evil one.

My prayer is not that you take them out of the world but that you protect them from the evil one. John 17:15 But the Lord is faithful, and he will strengthen and protect you from the evil one. 2 Thessalonians 3:3

### God is faithful even when <u>you are not</u>.

If we are faithless, he will remain faithful, for he cannot disown himself. 2 Timothy 2:13

# • God is faithful to **forgive** your **sins**.

"If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness." 1 John 1:9

# • How has God been <u>faithful to you?</u>

Your unfailing love, O Lord, is as vast as the heavens; your faithfulness reaches beyond the clouds. Psalm 36:5
