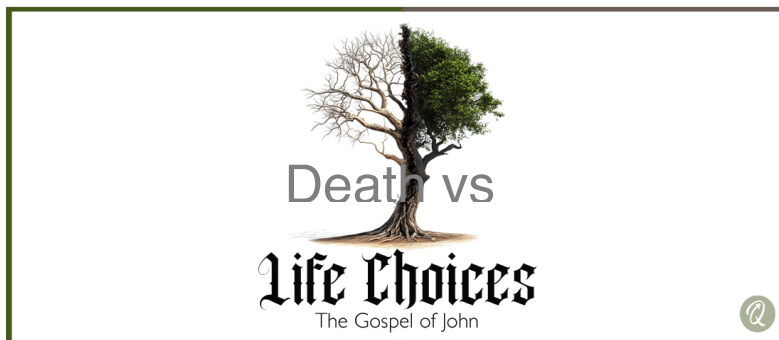

- What does it mean to trust the work of Christ rather than our own efforts? How do we do that?

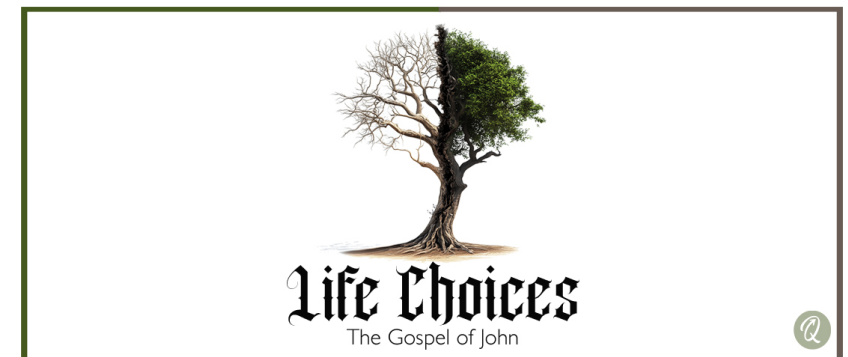
