- Who in your life might God be inviting you to pray for or intentionally love—even if they're difficult?

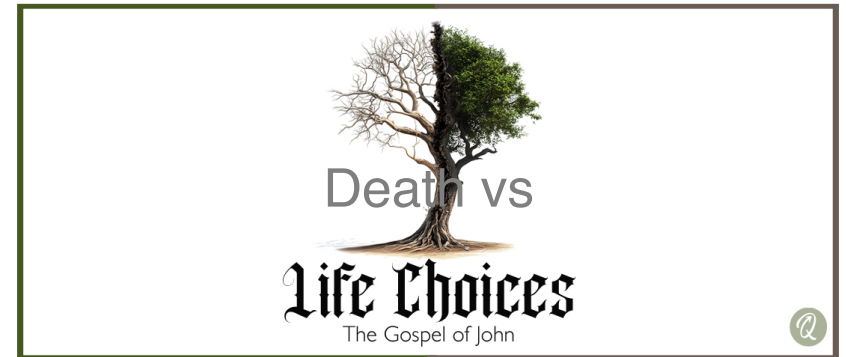
